15th IAU WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP - AVON - 30 August to 4 September

The 15th IAU World Crossbow Championship will soon get underway in Avon, northern France, from August 30 to September 4. Over 200 shooters from 14 countries have already registered to participate in 24 events in the disciplines of Field-crossbow, 30 meter Match-crossbow and 10 meter Match-crossbow at the shooting ranges in Vulains-sur-Seine. The IAU President Gérard BOUTTEVILLE, will officially open the 15th IAU World Championship at the opening ceremony on August 31 at 7.30 pm. Amongst the invited guests will be representatives of the shooting federations of Algeria, Cameroun and India - all three organizations being prospective new member nations for the IAU. The Kazakhstan archery and dart federation (member of the international archery federation FITA) has also applied to join the IAU.

The World Championship in Avon will see all three IAU crossbow disciplines contested side-by-side at the same venue. The event will also mark the international début of the portable 30 meter Match-crossbow target system which has been developed in Holland by the National Crossbow Federation.

The activities will be managed by the Coordinator of the French Guilds Jacques COLLOT. IAU GENERAL ASSEMBLY 2010

The 2010 IAU General Assembly will take place at Maison dans la Vallée, Avon, France on Wednesday September 1st at 6pm. Delegates from 14 national federations are expected to attend the meeting which will elect the members of the IAU Executive and Technical Committees for the next 4 years.

The IAU President Gérard BOUTTEVILLE (FRA) and the members of the IAU Executive Committee are standing for re-election. IAU Vice President for Asia Madam Pearl BIN HO will arrive from Chinese Taipei with her daughter Ning-Ning MAHLMANN (USA). In addition to the post of Secretary General Charles MÉCHIN (FRA) is standing for election as Chairman of the Field Division Technical Committee, taking over from Pavel KASZONYI (CZE) who will stand for election as a member of the Field TC. Alexander VARENNIA (RUS) has been nominated as IAU Vice-President for the Commonwealth of Independent States (new post). Amongst the new candidates for election to the IAU Technical Committees are: Field TC -Andreas HENNE (GER), Zeljko TIJAN (CRO) and Yuri LISSICHKO (RUS), Match TC - Josef BECKMANN (GER) and Istvan MATRAI (HUN).
