The award ceremony and a tombola will take place Sunday, 08.08.2010 at about 16:00 hours.

ATTENTION - limited Starting Capacities !!!

Registrations can only be accepted up to the capacity of the shooting range.

Match times:

Match starting times are binding. There will be no substitute start, once the shooter failed to be on the line in due time. Carefully check your starting times. In case of crossovers or other failures instantly notify the tournament management.

Rules:

The following rules apply to the whole tournament:

Sporting rules PPC-1500 (acc. to ÖSB [Austrian shooters association]) Version 2010 and further on the Police Pistol Rules of the NRA.

The general regulations of the "Österreichische Schießordnung" [Austrian shooting regulation] apply.

Protective glasses and hearing protectors are mandatory!

Weapon and equipment compliancy checks will take place on a random basis.

Score card:

For each match the shooter will receive a scoring card.

The original card is for the tournament management. The card has to be filled out properly. Corrections or erasures on the scoring card are not allowed. The signed card has to be delivered to the tournament management **within 30 minutes** after the end of the respective match.

The delivered card counts irrevocably.

Missing hits on a score card are unconsidered.

Excessive hits on a score card will be subtracted (the best) until the correct number of hits is reached. Reclamations concerning this procedure are invalid.

Scoring:

Each shooter scores the target of his right neighbour. The shooter on the most right scores the target of range 1.

The shooter, who fired at the targets to be scored, is not present while his targets are scored. The scorer places the completely filled out scoring card with the targets.

After that the shooter controls the scoring card and his targets. In case he does not agree with the scoring, he brings his targets and scoring card to the jury (tournament management).

While his targets are scored the shooter is not present at his targets!

He does not take influence on the scorer. This would be considered unsportsmanlike conduct. The tournament management reserves the right to control these principles.

<u>Awards</u>

In each match there will be an award for the overall winner. The teams and the first three places in each match and each class will be awarded a certificate.

Tombola:

Prizes and the like will be drawn by the shooters present at the tombola after the award ceremony.

Announcements:

With his registration the shooter accepts that his name and other necessary data will be published in the list of results and on the internet.

ATTENTION: The exact match starting times will be published on the internet pages www.wa1500.org and www.klsv.at.

Legal disclaimer:

Each shooter is responsible for his fired shots! The tournament management and the organizing club take no responsibility for any kind of accidents! With his registration the shooter accepts all the rules as stated in this invitation.

Appeal Jury:

Handgun Sports Director and 3 experienced shooters (from different clubs - preferably range officers). Appeal fee: Euro € 50,-

General note / weather:

The whole tournament is an open air event and will be conducted at <u>any</u> weather situation. Shelters for equipment and safety area will exist.

Approaching description:

Coming from Passau take the highway A9 direction Graz, at St. Michael change direction to Judenburg/Klagenfurt/Friesach. On the interstate B 317 in Zwischenwässern turn right after the railway underpass, direction Straßburg.

Coming from Salzburg take the highway A10 up to Radstadt, then drive over the Radstädter Tauern / Obertauern into the Murtal up to Schiefling. Here turn right on the interstate B 317, direction Klagenfurt/Friesach. For the rest look above.

Coming from Vienna take the highway A 2 until Klagenfurt-north. Change on the interstate S 37 / B 317, direction St. Veit/Friesach. The rest is like above, but you have to turn left before the railway underpass.

Coming from Italy or Slovenia take the highway A 2 via Villach to Klagenfurt-north and then proceed as described above.

The shooting range is situated somewhat covered about 2 km before you reach Straßburg, but will be signposted accordingly.

For users of a navigation/gps system: Enter the address of the shooting range (stated above on page 1). With that you will reach a farm, then follow the gravel road through the farm and after a few hounded meters you will directly get to the shooting range.

For using the highways and interstate roads a vignette is necessary (road tax)!
